PROJECT: Community Garden Expansion - Clinton

LOCATION: Maybarton Community Garden DATE: SUNDAY, April 10th, 9AM – 3PM VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: 15 people each session (AM & PM)

DESCRIPTION: The Maybarton Community Garden is growing and needs 10 new beds to accommodate the demand from the community. Help us prepare the garden for the season by:

- building and placing 15 raised bed garden frames (AM session)
- filling the beds with a layer of weed-blocking newspaper, soil and amendments (AM session)
- spreading mulch in the garden aisles and in the orchard (PM session)
- and installing two compost bins (PM session)

This project will be broken down into two sessions, a morning and an early afternoon session with lunch in between. We can utilize up to 15 people during each session and time the day to suit your schedule.

PROJECT: Community Garden Installation - Fitchburg

LOCATION: Cleghorn Community Garden DATE: TUESDAY, April 12, 9AM-3:30PM VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: 15-20 people each session (AM & PM)

DESCRIPTION: The Cleghorn Community Garden is moving! Help us shift the existing beds from the current corner lot to the large fenced-in field behind Saint Joseph's rectory. We'll have the help of the church maintenance equipment (front end loader!!), but we need human hands to:

- build 15 raised bed garden frames (AM session)
- place and fill the frames with a layer of weed-blocking newspaper and soil (AM session)
- complete the morning's frame building / installing work (PM session)
- plant two apple trees (PM session)

This project is a large one and we can utilize up to 20 people during the morning session and 15 during the afternoon session.

PROJECT: Community Garden Spring Cleaning - Leominster

LOCATION: Pierce Meadow Community Garden DATE: WEDNESDAY, April 13, 9AM – 2PM VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: 10-15 people each session (AM & PM)

DESCRIPTION: Help us kick off the spring growing season by sprucing up the Pierce Meadow Community Garden by:

- building 3 raised bed garden frames (AM session)
- adding soil and soil amendments (AM session)
- applying a thick layer of mulch to the garden aisles to discourage weed growth *(PM session)*
- and turning over the compost piles to encourage quicker decomposition (AM and/or PM session)

This project is broken down into two sessions: typically a morning and early afternoon session with lunch break in between. We can utilize up to 15 volunteers during each session and time the day to suit your schedule.

PROJECT: Community Garden Clean Up - Fitchburg LOCATION: Prichard St. Community Garden DATE: THURSDAY, April 14, 2:30-4PM VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: 5-8 people

DESCRIPTION: Help us kick off the spring growing season by sprucing up the Prichard St. Community Garden by:

- pulling weeds from the garden beds and aisles
- turning the compost to speed decomposition
- painting the trunks of the peach trees to discourage pests
- fertilizing the peach trees

We can utilize up to 8 volunteers for this project. Pizza will be provided!

PROJECT: Community Garden Expansion - Fitchburg

LOCATION: Sundial Community Garden and Orchard DATE: SATURDAY, April 16th, 9AM – 2PM VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: 10-15 people each session (AM & PM)

DESCRIPTION: The Sundial Community Garden is growing and needs 7 new beds to accommodate the demand from the community. Help us prepare the garden for the season by:

- building and placing 7 raised bed garden frames (AM session)
- filling the beds with a layer of weed-blocking newspaper and soil (AM session)
- spreading mulch in the garden aisles (AM session)
- turning over the compost piles to encourage quicker decomposition (PM session)
- repositioning the pear trees in the orchard (PM session)
- painting the pear tree trunks to discourage pests (PM session)
- fertilizing the pear trees

This project will be broken down into two sessions, a morning and an early afternoon session with lunch in between. We can utilize up to 15 people during each session and time the day to suit your schedule.

PROJECT: Community Garden Clean Up - Clinton

LOCATION: Clinton Community Garden DATE: TBD VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: 15 people

DESCRIPTION: Help us kick off the spring growing season by sprucing up the Clinton Community Garden by:

- repainting the garden sign
- pulling weeds from the garden beds and aisles
- mending the garden fence and gate
- assembling the compost bin

We can utilize up to 15 volunteers during each session and time the day to suit your schedule. Pizza will be provided!
